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About the project

The YE-2C overall goal is engaging and empowering young people in circularity actions for transforming cities into circular and live able for better opportunities for employment, clean environment and inclusiveness.

The project is linked to the horizontal priority environmental sustainability as it approaches a deep perspective of circular cities through adoption of circular economy principles. Additionally, the project is linked with the digital dimension as it aims using the digital- tools with the purpose of mapping the circularity of cities proposing actions for start-up businesses and sustainability.

The project's main aims are:

- Empowering young professionals with appropriate tools and methods to have a positive impact on transforming cities into circular.
- Engaging and enabling rural youth to effectively contribute to increasing circularity actions in peripheral/rural areas for economic development and employability.
- Disseminating the results and the methodology of the project with the purpose to make a wider impact to the society through online events, virtual communication.

About the Training Course

<u>The scope of the training</u> is to equip youth workers with practical experience on estimating the circularity of cities in urban and rural areas through the acquired curricula.

Methodology: Non-Formal Education methods comprising Icebreakers, Team Building activities, Roundtables, Simulations, Workshops, Case Studies, practical work, Teamwork aimed in testing the circular economy template produced the experts of the project. For 7 days the youth workers will be acquired with hands-on experience on using the template for estimating the circularity of cities in urban and rural areas through the acquired curricula in their countries.

Expectation from the participants:

The youth workers that will participate in the Training Course will be the coaches who will lead the local activities in their countries. The youth workers who have already acquired knowledge and skills on using the template and the CE business plans will be working with youth people with fewer opportunities. There will be 7 days duration where youth workers will be engaged in local activities after the training course.
