Getting around in Vienna

Vienna has a dense public transport network. Buses, trams and U-Bahn stops are always nearby. The system uses an honour system. There are no turnstiles or barriers, but ticket inspectors do check tickets and the fines are high. Always carry a valid ticket. Tickets are available online at shop.wienmobil.at/en/products, via the WienMobil app or at machines at stations.

Stamp your single-ticket before entering the U-Bahn staircase or escalator. Stamp machines are next to the stairs. On trams and buses, stamp your ticket when boarding. Blue stamp boxes are usually in the middle near the doors.

For real-time updates and route planning, download the WienMobil app.

Getting around in Ebensee

The municipality has two trainstops and the Landungsplatz stop is only serviced with the regional trains (REX). There are only a few bus-stops and we be on foot in Ebensee and you will not need any tickets in Ebensee.
